Succulent Terrarium Care

Terrarium Care: Terrariums are great low maintenance miniature gardens grown indoors. Terrariums can be grown in an open or closed container. These trendy decorative pieces can be stylized a million ways, the possibilities are endless!

The two most important factors you must consider when caring for your terrarium are sunlight and water.

Sunlight: Place your terrarium in a bright area with indirect sunlight. Near a south or east facing window is an ideal spot. However, avoid placing it in direct sunlight which can burn the leaves of your plant.

Water: Water plants thoroughly when the soil is completely dry. When you notice the soil pulling away from the edge of the pot, it is time to water. Most succulents require watering once every week, sometimes even once every two weeks. Do not overwater. We recommend watering with a dixie cup, watering at the base of the plant rather than over the leaves which can cause the plant to rot.

Fertilizer: You should not add any fertilizer to your terrarium. The goal is to keep the plants very small, so you do not want to encourage rapid growth. The plants will get the nutrients they need from the soil.

Once your plants get to large for the container, move them to a slightly larger pot and replace with new mini house-plants. If you have any questions, come see us at the store!
